SUBJECT: America’s Job Center of California Locations

RECOMMENDATION: That the Workforce Development Board (WDB) approve the America’s Job Center of California (AJCC) locations within Riverside County as follows:

1. Three (3) comprehensive AJCC sites located in the cities of Riverside, Hemet and Indio; and
2. Two (2) AJCC satellite sites located in the cities of Moreno Valley and Blythe.

BACKGROUND: AJCC locations are core to the local workforce system. These centers serve as all-inclusive access points for career services, education and training for a wide range of customers. The purpose of this action item is to obtain the Workforce Development Board’s approval of the sites selected to serve as comprehensive and satellite AJCC offices within the Riverside County Local Area.

AJCC sites were strategically selected to cover the major regions of the County. Factors used in site selection include population density, poverty rates, unemployment rates, business density, accessibility and proximity of other community services. Availability of funding to deliver the appropriate mix of services required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) is also a determining factor when assessing the capacity and number of locations in the Local Area.

In addition to these five sites, the Mobile Workforce Development Center (Mobile One) will continue to provide on-demand services as needed. AJCC locations will be re-evaluated annually to ensure that the centers are cost-effective and meeting the needs of the Local Area.
