

WIB Bylaw Amendment

SECTION II. APPOINTMENT, REAPPOINTMENT AND DISQUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS

New Item

- D. The WIB identifies membership in accordance with the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA) in Section 117. Per Section 117, the WIB membership composition must include a specified number of public sector representatives from an array of public sector organizations.
1. The respective Board of Supervisor and WIB Chairman will be notified by the resigning WIB public sector member of his date of resignation and the name of the replacement through correspondence (formal letter or e-mail);
 2. The WIB shall identify someone from the resigning WIB member's organization as a replacement for later appointment to the WIB by the Board of Supervisor; and
 3. Nominations to fill any such vacancy, together with appropriate disclosure statements and documentation, shall be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for consideration and appointment.
