SUBJECT: Council for Youth Development Membership Appointment

RECOMMENDATION: That the Council for Youth Development (CYD) recommends the Workforce Investment Board (WIB) approve the appointment of Kim McNulty and Tracey Vackar to the CYD..

Kim McNulty is a native of Palm Springs, California. She attended the University of San Diego and graduated cum laude with a degree in English. She is a project management, education and communications consultant and has provided leadership to the Coachella Valley Economic Partnership's Career Pathways Initiative since its inception in 2005. In November 2006, this James Irvine Foundation funded initiative was recognized as a national best practice by the Ford Motor Company Fund through their Next Generation Learning Community initiative.

Kim's professional experience includes serving as Executive Director for the Palm Springs Economic Development Corporation; six years as Director of Marketing for Maryanov Madsen Gordon & Campbell, CPAs and thirteen years with the Palm Springs Desert Resorts Convention and Visitors Bureau as Film Commissioner and Communications Manager for the desert resort communities.

Kim serves on the Business Education Resource Group for the California (CA) Department of Education and is a member of the Riverside County Workforce Investment Board's Eastern Region Committee. In addition, she helped pioneer Xavier College Preparatory High School in Palm Desert, CA and currently serves on Xavier's Board of regents.

Tracey Vackar has been in education for the past 17 years with the Riverside County Office of Education, where she works in the Career Technical Education (CTE) Unit as the Project Coordinator. Tracey's expertise is in School to Career program, vocational classes, Career Technical Education Pathways, academy programs, CTE curriculum, Adult Education, and CTE state credentialing requirements.

Tracey has been named the 2010 Citizen of the Year for the City of Moreno Valley and Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce. In addition, she has been elected and served on the Moreno Valley Unified School District Board of Education for 18 years, and is the current President of the Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center Board of Directors.
