

#### Riverside Adult School 22-23 Registration & Class Information



Registration for Citizenship, ESL, GED and High School Diploma classes The registration process is as follows:

- 1. Complete the online registration form here: bit.ly/RASCLASS which will be open February 6 10th
- 2. You will receive an email within 2-3 days of completing the registration form with information about how to schedule your testing appointment. An in person CASAS test is required in order to register for either in person or online ESL/GED or High School Diploma classes at Riverside Adult School. (Students registering for the high school diploma program must submit an unofficial copy of their high school transcript during registration. Please request your record from your high school now to ensure you have the transcript for registration.) Testing appointments will be the week of February 13-16.
- 3. Attend your in person testing appointment. You will select your class schedule and indicate whether you would like to attend class in person or online during your testing appointment.
- 4. You can begin classes once your in person test is completed.

#### ESL/English as a Second Language

ESL courses give English learners opportunities to study and practice English language communications skills, including listening, speaking, reading, writing, and critical thinking. Competency-based courses span seven levels ranging from basic literacy to advanced English language development.

In person ESL classes for beginning, intermediate and advanced level students are offered according to the following schedule:

8:45am - 12:15pm Mon, Wed & Fri or 8:45am - 12:15pm Tues & Thurs or 5:30pm - 8:00pm Mon & Wed or 5:30pm - 8:00pm Tues & Thurs

Online ESL classes for intermediate and advanced level students are offered according to the following schedule.

Students must have a CASAS reading level of 210 or higher to register for online ESL classes.

Intermediate and Advanced ESL meets online Monday through Friday 8:45am to 10:25am or 10:30am to 12:15pm or Monday through Thursday from 1:00-3:00pm

#### Citizenship

This course provides an overview of United States history and the structure of Federal, State, County and City government. - Coordinates with the needs of state and local employers
- Engages with employers through sector strategies and partnerships
- Reinforces career pathways and integrates education, training through work-based learning
- Measures performance outcomes and shared data
