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**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 5,800 over the month and up 26,600 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.1 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 5.5 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.2 percent in Riverside County, and 5.1 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between February 2024 and March 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,686,500 to 1,692,300, an increase of 5,800 jobs. Agricultural employment remained unchanged.

- Government gained the most over the month adding 2,300 jobs. Most of the job increase registered in local government (up 2,100), more specifically in local government educational services (up 2,100). Federal government and state government gained 100 jobs each completing the overall sectoral gain.
- Private education and health services gained 2,000 jobs. Health care and social assistance increased by 1,900 jobs, followed by job additions in private educational services with an increase of 100 jobs. Four other sectors increased over the month including construction (up 1,000).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities lost the most jobs over the month (down 900). Transportation, warehousing, and utilities lost the most within the sector (down 700), followed by losses in wholesale trade (down 300). Retail trade offset declines with an addition of 100 jobs. Two other sectors, manufacturing and financial activities, declined over the month with a loss of 300 jobs each. Mining and logging and information remained unchanged over the month.

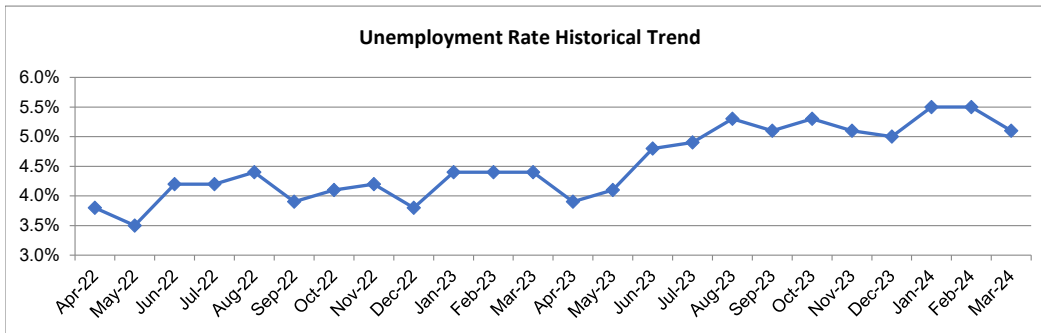
Between March 2023 and March 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 26,600, a 1.6 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 900 jobs or 7.5 percent.

- Private education and health services added 22,400 jobs, the most over the year. Health care and social assistance added 21,200 jobs, followed by additions in private educational services (up 1,200).
- Government increased by 12,800 jobs. Local government increased the most within the sector adding 11,500 jobs. Increases in federal government (up 800) and state government (up 500) completed the overall sectoral gain. Three other sectors increased over the year.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities (down 5,700) lost the most jobs over the year. Within the sector, retail trade (down 2,400) lost the most jobs, followed by losses in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 1,900), and wholesale trade (down 1,400).
- Leisure and hospitality declined by 4,900 jobs. Most of the decline was recorded in accommodation and food services (down 4,100), followed by losses in arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 800). Four other sectors declined over the year including manufacturing (down 3,800).
