**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 5,700 over the month and up 31,100 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.3 percent in June 2024, up from a revised 4.3 percent in May 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.3 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.4 percent in Riverside County, and 5.2 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between May 2024 and June 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,701,100 to 1,706,800, an increase of 5,700 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 1,300 jobs.

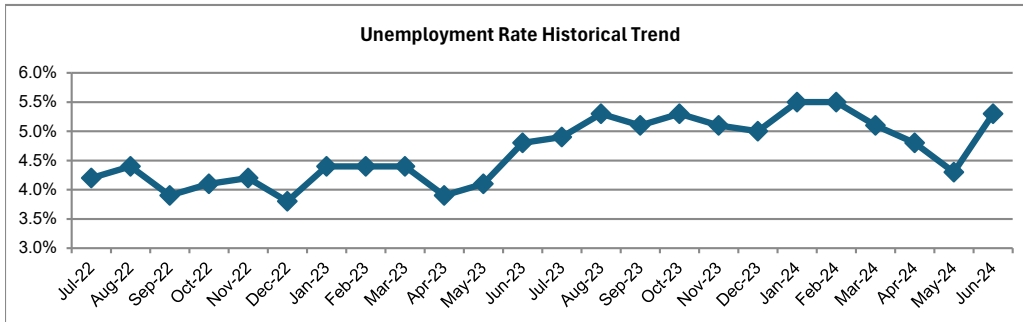
- Trade, transportation, and utilities added the most jobs over the month, increasing by 3,100 jobs. Within the sector, both wholesale trade and transportation, warehousing, and utilities gained 1,100 jobs each. Retail trade completed the overall sectoral gain with an increase of 900 jobs.
- Private education and health services added 1,400 jobs. All the job additions registered in health care and social assistance (up 2,300). Private educational services offset job increases with a decline of 900 jobs. Six other sectors registered job increases including construction (up 1,400), manufacturing (up 500), and other services (up 200).
- Only two sectors declined over the month. Professional and business services lost 700 jobs and government lost 600 jobs. Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between June 2023 and June 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 31,100, a 1.9 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 1,000 jobs or 6.8 percent.

- Private education and health services added 21,400 jobs over the year. Most of the job additions registered in health care and social assistance (up 19,600). Private educational services gained 1,800 jobs completing the overall sectoral increase.
- Government increased by 12,300 jobs. Most job additions registered in local government (up 11,800), followed by federal government (up 300), and state government (up 200). Four other industries added jobs over the year, including construction (up 1,100) and trade, transportation, and utilities (up 700).
- Manufacturing lost the most jobs over the year, declining by 2,500 jobs. Within the sector, durable goods declined by 1,500 jobs, followed by job losses in non-durable goods (down 1,000).
- Leisure and hospitality lost 1,600 jobs. All the job loss registered in accommodation and food services (down 1,900). Arts, entertainment, and recreation offset declines with an increase of 300 jobs. Three other sectors declined over the year: information (down 500), financial activities (down 400), and other services (down 100).
