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**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 16,900 over the month and up 23,600 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.5 percent in October 2024, up from a revised 5.4 percent in September 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.4 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.6 percent in Riverside County, and 5.3 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between September 2024 and October 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,707,500 to 1,724,400, an increase of 16,900 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 1,300 jobs.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities (up 5,500) had the largest increase over the month. Most of the increase registered in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 2,700) and retail trade (up 2,400). Wholesale trade (up 400) completed the overall sectoral increase.
- Government increased by 5,100 jobs. Most of the gain was recorded in local government (up 5,100) followed by state government (up 100). Federal government (down 100) offset sectoral increases.
- Private education and health services added 2,900 jobs. Most the job increases were in health care and social assistance (up 2,100), followed by increases in private educational services (up 800). Four other sectors increased over the month including professional and business services (up 1,900).
- Manufacturing was the only sector to decline over the month, losing 1,000 jobs. Most of the job loss registered in durable goods (down 600), followed by non-durable goods (down 400). Three sectors remained unchanged: mining and logging, information, and other services.

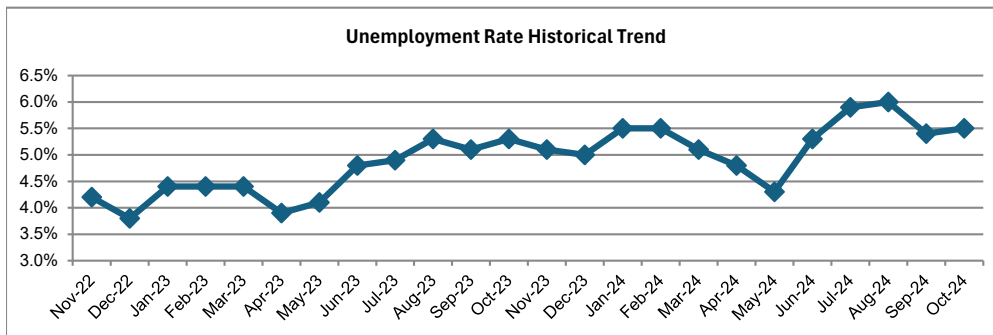
Between October 2023 and October 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 23,600, a 1.4 percent change. Agricultural employment remained unchanged.

- Private education and health services had the largest increase over the year, adding 18,200 jobs. All the job increase was in health care and social assistance (up 18,700) but was offset by a decline of 500 jobs in private educational services.
- Government increased by 9,400 jobs. Most of the job additions were recorded in local government (up 9,200), followed by increases in state government (up 300). Federal government (down 100) offset overall sectoral increases. Two other sectors increased over the year including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 4,500).
- Manufacturing lost the most jobs over the year with a decline of 3,700 jobs. Most of the decline posted in durable goods (down 2,500). Non-durable goods (down 1,200) completed the overall sectoral decrease. Five other sectors declined over the year including construction (down 2,600). Mining and logging remained unchanged.
