**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 9,600 over the month and up 33,200 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.4 percent in September 2024, down from a revised 6.0 percent in August 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.6 percent in Riverside County, and 5.2 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between August 2024 and September 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,699,000 to 1,708,600, an increase of 9,600 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 700 jobs.

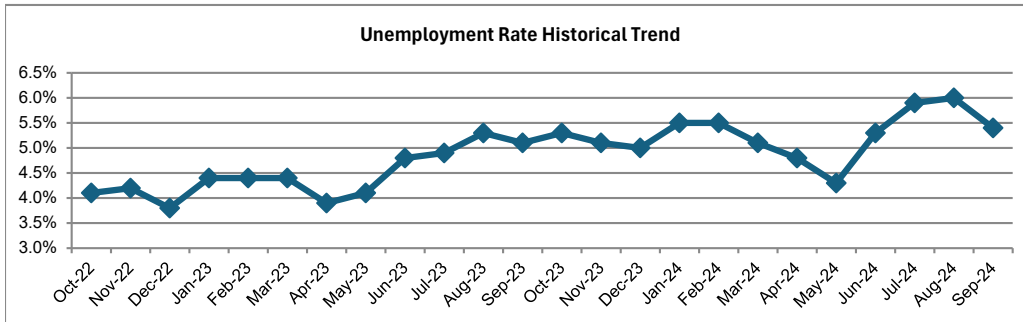
- Government (up 9,100) added the most jobs over the month. Within the sector, local government increased by 8,600 jobs followed by job additions in state government (up 500). Federal government remained unchanged.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities gained 3,800 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities gained the most within the sector adding 2,600 jobs. Increases in retail trade (up 900) and wholesale trade (up 300) completed the overall sectoral gains. Three other sectors increased over the month, including private education and health services (up 1,600).
- Construction (down 2,200) lost the most jobs over the month. Most of the decline registered in specialty trade contractors (down 1,500). Construction of buildings (down 500) and heavy and civil engineering construction (down 200) both declined within the sector. Four other sectors lost jobs, including leisure and hospitality (down 1,500). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between September 2023 and September 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 33,200, a 2.0 percent change. Agricultural employment decreased by 100 jobs or 0.8 percent.

- Private education and health services gained the most jobs over the year, adding 18,100 jobs. All the job additions registered in health care and social assistance (up 18,500). Private educational services offset job increases with a decline of 400 jobs.
- Government increased by 11,200 jobs. Most of the job additions registered in local government (up 10,700), followed by increases in state government (up 400). Federal government (up 100) completed the overall sectoral increase. Two other sectors increased over the year, including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 8,000).
- Manufacturing lost the most jobs over the year with a decline of 2,500 jobs. Most of the decline posted in durable goods (down 1,900). Non-durable goods (down 600) completed the overall sectoral decline. Five other sectors declined over the year, including construction (down 1,800). Mining and logging remained unchanged.
