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**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 7,200 over the month and up 33,600 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 6.0 percent in August 2024, up from a revised 5.9 percent in July 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.9 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 6.2 percent in Riverside County, and 5.7 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between July 2024 and August 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,691,900 to 1,699,100, an increase of 7,200 jobs. Agricultural employment decreased by 2,500 jobs.

- Government (up 5,900) had the largest increase over the month. Local government was the only subsector to increase employment, adding 6,900 jobs. State government (down 900) and federal government (down 100) offset sectoral increases.
- Private education and health services added 2,200 jobs, with the entire increase registered in health care and social assistance (up 2,200). Private educational services remained unchanged.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities increased by 1,100 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities added 500 jobs, followed by increases both in retail trade (up 400) and wholesale trade (up 200). Only one other sector increased over the month: professional and business services (up 1,000).
- Other services declined the most over the month, losing 700 jobs. Within the sector, repair and maintenance lost 300 jobs, followed by job losses in personal and laundry services (down 100). Five sectors also declined over the month, including construction (down 600). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

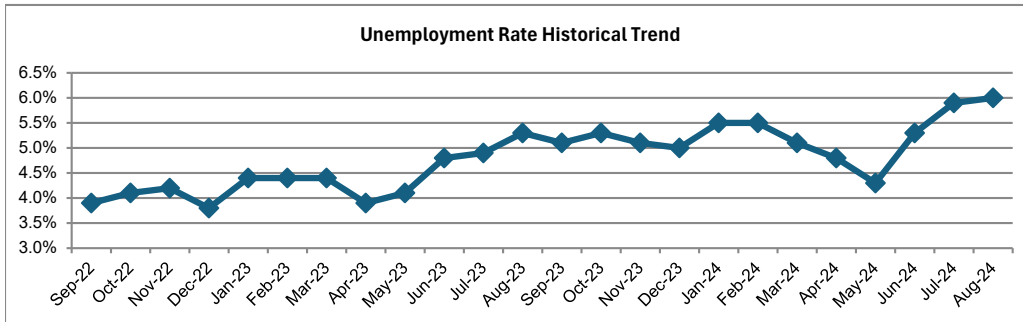
Between August 2023 and August 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 33,600, a 2.0 percent change. Agricultural employment decreased by 300 jobs or 2.5 percent.

- Private education and health services gained the most jobs over the year, adding 18,300 jobs. All the job increase registered in health care and social assistance (up 19,000). Private educational services offset job increases with a decline of 700 jobs.
- Government increased by 11,700 jobs. Most of the job additions registered in local government (up 11,200), followed by increases in state government (up 400). Federal government (up 100) completed the overall sectoral increase. Four other sectors increased over the year, including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 4,600).
- Manufacturing lost the most jobs over the year with a decline of 2,500 jobs. Most of the decline posted in durable goods (down 1,700). Non-durable goods (down 800) completed the overall sectoral decline. Three other sectors declined over the year, including other services (down 1,400). Mining and logging remained unchanged.
